### **ROAD COURSE EXPANDED TO FOUR MILES IN LENGTH**

With construction of the road course and other amenities scheduled to begin in the first quarter of 2007, Gage stated it can't begin too soon now that the plans are finalized on the course.

"We simply cannot wait to get started on the construction," he explained. "We have had an initial cut of the track since July, but to now be a step closer to actually laying the asphalt is exciting!"
